

Health Policies:

For the protection of the children, the child care workers as well as the health of your child please be courteous and refrain from bringing an ill child to child care.

- We cannot accept a child or Child Care Worker who has **any of** the following conditions:
 - Any type of contagious or communicable disease.
 - Fever (100°F or higher within the past 24 hours)
 - If you had to give your child medicine the day before or the morning of - that still means they cannot come to child care
 - Fever that comes and goes over several days
 - Skin rash
 - Strep throat – consult Dr.- must have been on antibiotics and no fever for 24 hours
 - Ear infection - consult Dr. - must have been on antibiotics and no fever for 24 hours
 - Sore throat
 - Persistent Cough
 - Croupy Cough
 - Congested to the point he/she has heavy breathing
 - Runny nose that is not clear
 - Constant runny nose
 - Drainage in eyes
 - Diarrhea or vomiting (within the last 24 hours)
 - On any medication to treat the above symptoms (Parent's please be honest about your child being on medication)
 - Any other symptom that might indicate contagious illness

Parents, you know your child better than anyone, please keep your child home if they are not feeling well.

It will ultimately be at the discretion of the Child Care Coordinator or the Children's Ministry Directors if a child must be sent home because they are ill.
